Carriers of Hope is looking for a Children's Worker

Carriers of Hope, Coventry, in Partnership with BBC Children in Need, is seeking to employ a part-time Children's Worker to work with the Children and Volunteers involved in our various services and activities.

The salary will be £10,000 per year for 16 hours per week, which will be worked flexibly although there are two fixed times of Tuesday and Wednesday mornings, from 8.00 to 12 noon.

We are looking for someone with well-developed skills in the area of planning and delivering activities for children; and who is skilled at understanding the needs of BME children and young people. The person needs to be really happy to work with, and lead, a team of volunteers and not be put off by the idea of starting new services from scratch.
