19th March - Pray for Karen (DP) and the Trustees as they have a virtual meeting this evening 6.30pm-9pm. Pray also for the AGM's taking place over the Diocese as branch leaders retire and new leaders and committees begin their new triennium.

24th March - Palm Sunday - The day Jesus rode on a donkey into Jerusalem, palm leaves and garments strewn in his way.

Lord we think of this day and what is to come : Ride on, Ride on in majesty! Hark all the tribes "Hosanna!" cry, O Saviour meek, pursue your road, with palms and scattered garments strewed.

Holy Week - As Holy week progressed, Jesus became more lowly ...the Suffering Servant, the Servant King.....washing the Disciples feet, carrying his cross....but amazingly giving his disciples a Last Supper where he took a loaf of bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and gave it to them saying, "This is my body which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me. After supper he took another cup of wine and said 'This cup is the new covenant, between God and his people - an agreement confirmed with my blood, which is poured out as a sacrifice for you'. Luke 22:19-20.

25th March - The Annunciation of our Lord to the blessed Virgin Mary -Lady Day. Pray for the Mothers' Union services on this day.

28th March - Maundy Thursday - As we come to Maundy Thursday, in your prayers and contemplationhave a picture in your mind of:The cross - rough wood - Draped in red materialAt the foot of the cross - A pile of nails, a small bag of silver coins and dice scattered about, a rusty hammer.

Take time to be quiet and allow this picture to speak to you.

When I survey the wondrous cross, on which the Prince of glory died My richest gain I count but loss, and pour contempt on all my pride.

29th March - Good Friday - We remember today the pain and suffering of the cross and all that Jesus endured. Such a sacrifice of love for us.

It is a thing most wonderful, almost too wonderful to be, that God's own Son should come from heaven and die to save a child like me

EASTER EVE - As our journey through Lent is nearing its climax we pray:-

Father God, today we you praise and glory. Thank you for your Son Jesus, through you the Saviour of the world.

God so loved the world that He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life. (John 3:16)

31st March - Easter Sunday. As we come to this special day imagine the picture in your mind of Mary Magdalene coming to the tomb - still grieving and finds the tomb empty - exacerbating her grief. Mistaking Jesus for a gardener, she begs him to tell her where they have taken her Lord..... After a moment Jesus says her name with such love in his voice....MARY....and she turns, maybe has to wipe the tears from her eyes as she recognises that voice. Imagine the surprise and awe as it dawns upon her and she breathes

' Rabboni ! (My Teacher) Then her grief becomes such Joy! Excitement! that Jesus has to stop her throwing her arms around him.



Now imagine yourself in that picture and JESUS saying YOUR NAME! With such love and compassion ...breathe gently as you receive that love for you poured out on the cross.
